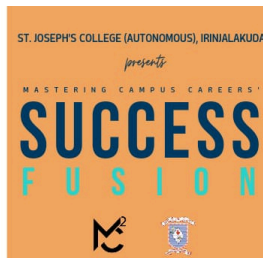

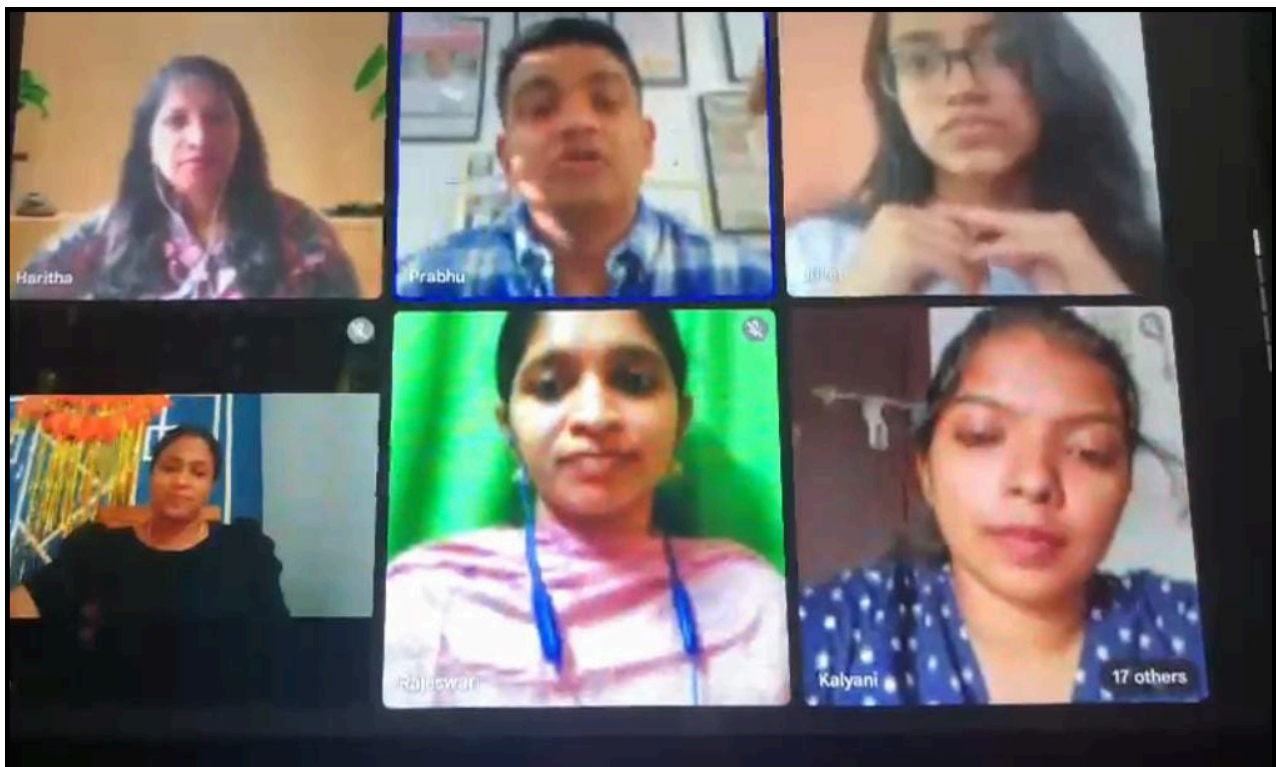

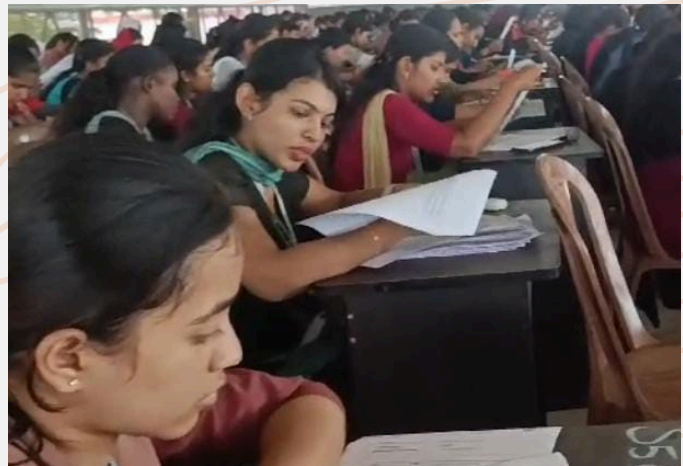




# COMMUNICATION TEST
